

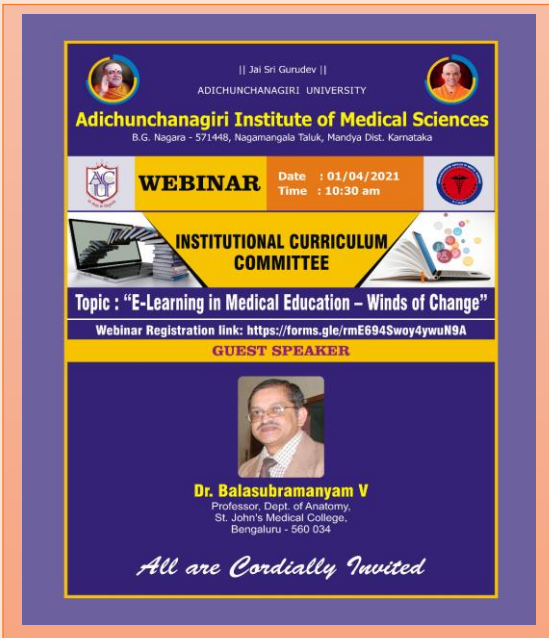

Report of Webinar on “e-Learning in Medical Education – Winds of Change”

Dr. Aliya Nusrath, Coordinator, Institutional Curriculum Committee & HoD, Department of Biochemistry welcomed the gathering. **Dr. MG Shivaramu**, Principal, AIMS & Dean, Health Sciences, Medical, provided the keynote address & spoke on the relevance & need for e teaching & learning. The guest speaker was introduced to the audience by Dr. Tejaswi HL, Associate Professor, Department of Anatomy, AIMS.

The resource person of the day was, the renowned speaker **Dr. Vaidyanathan Balasubramanyam**, Professor of Anatomy, St. John’s Medical college,

He gave a brief insight into, how technology can be used to enhance teaching learning mechanisms especially in the last one year wherein, most of the teaching learning process in all colleges, especially medical colleges had to be conducted online. He also displayed videos & photographs of various teaching learning processes that were undertaken in St. John’s Medical College, Bengaluru. He impressed upon the idea that technology can act as supplement to teaching and cannot substitute passionate, dedicated teachers & likewise learners also. During the interaction sessions, queries were raised regarding copyright issues while videos were used for teaching learning purposes which were addressed effectively by the guest speaker saying that such issues will not arise if utilized for nonprofit purposes.
