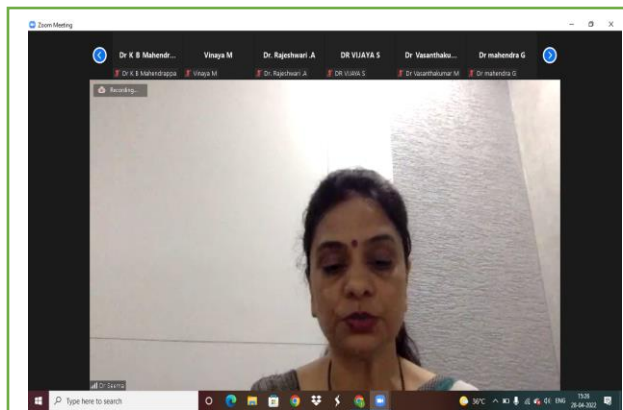
The webinar was attended by Dr. M.G.Shivaramu, Principal, AIMS, Dean, Faculty of Health Sciences (Medical), ACU, Dean Academics & Accreditation, Dr. Rupnarayan R, Principals of all the ACU constituent colleges, faculty members of various departments and members of all internal committees of AIMS & other constituent colleges of ACU, including NAAC, IQAC and other accreditation committees.
