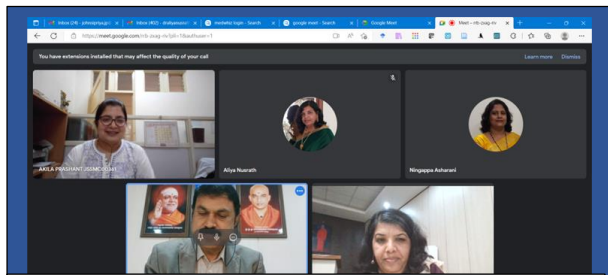

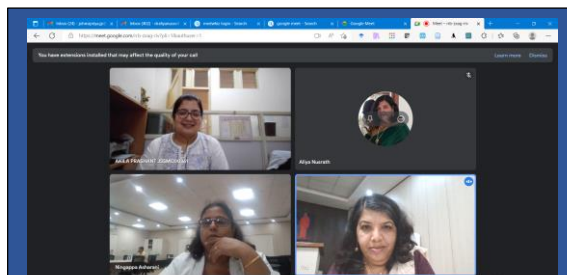
External Subject expert Dr. Akila Prashant provided the valuable comments and suggestions.

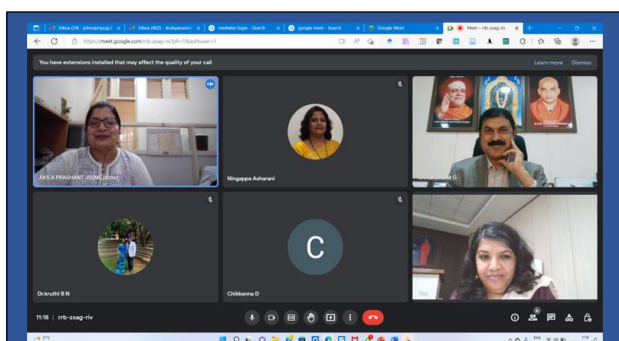

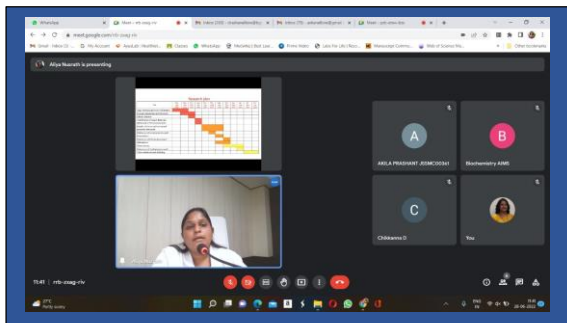

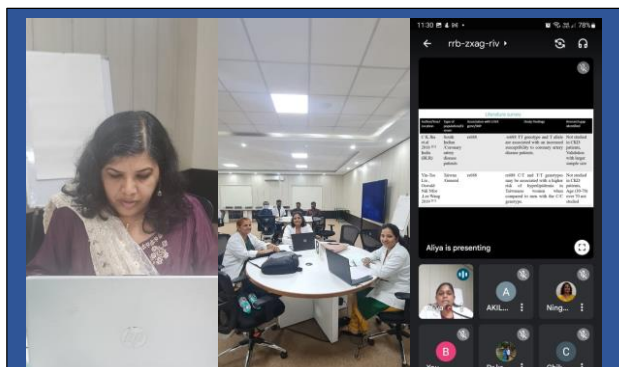
