INTERDEPARTMENTAL SEMINAR WITH OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY

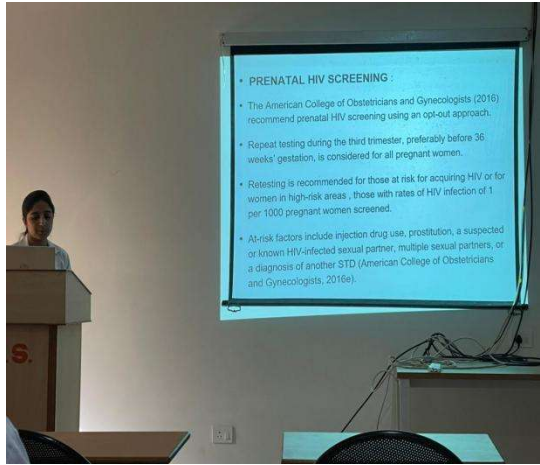
