Hepatitis B is a potentially life-threatening liver infection caused by the hepatitis B virus (HBV). It is a major global health problem. Hepatitis B vaccine is recommended in certain high-risk groups like medical students and healthcare workers. It is a safe and effective vaccine that offers 98% to 100% protection against hepatitis B. Hence Student support cell in association with NSS, AIMS unit had arranged vaccination for MBBS students from July 28th 2023 to August 1st 2023.

The main objective of the session was to vaccinate the under-graduates as they are susceptible to HBV infection during exposure to clinical cases & different procedure. The students were addressed about the Hepatitis B Infection and the importance of being vaccinated against the same.
