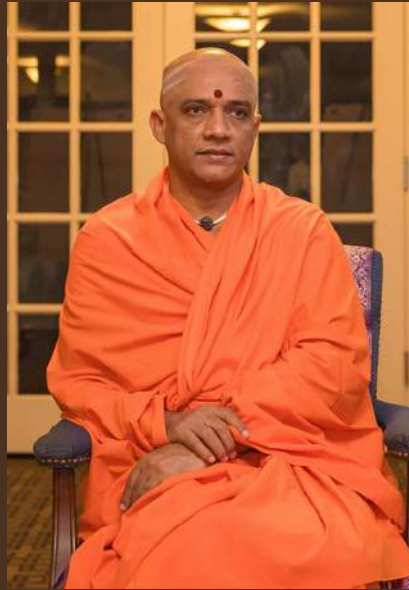

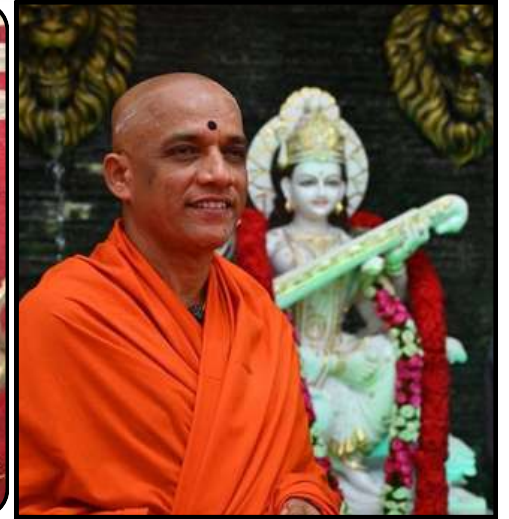


Ruby Reunion 2026 – Celebrating 40 Years of Togetherness (MBBS Batch of 1986)

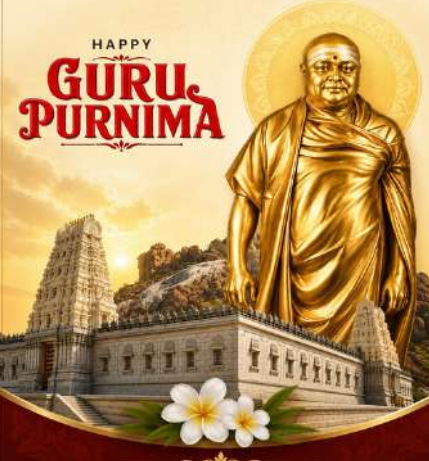

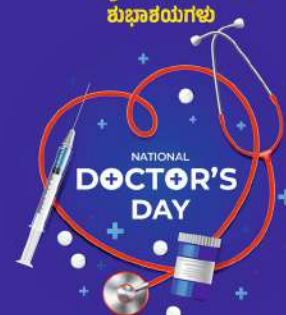

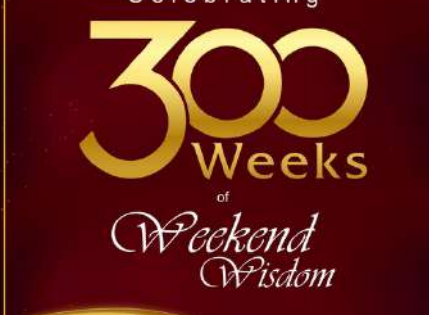
