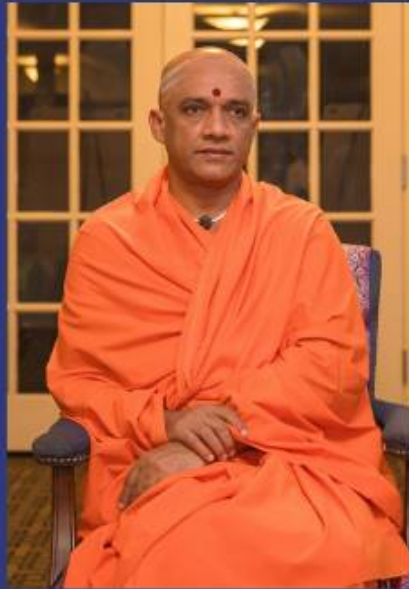

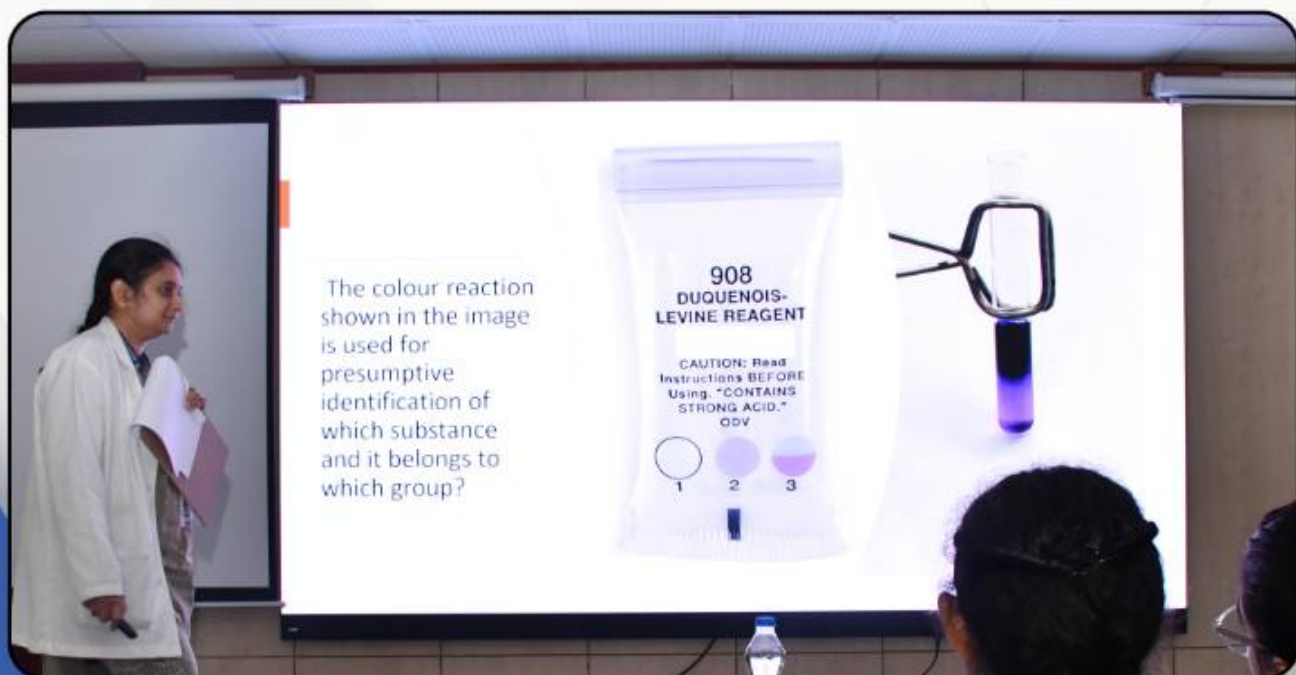




BIO QUIZ – 2026: NURTURING ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE IN BIOCHEMISTRY
